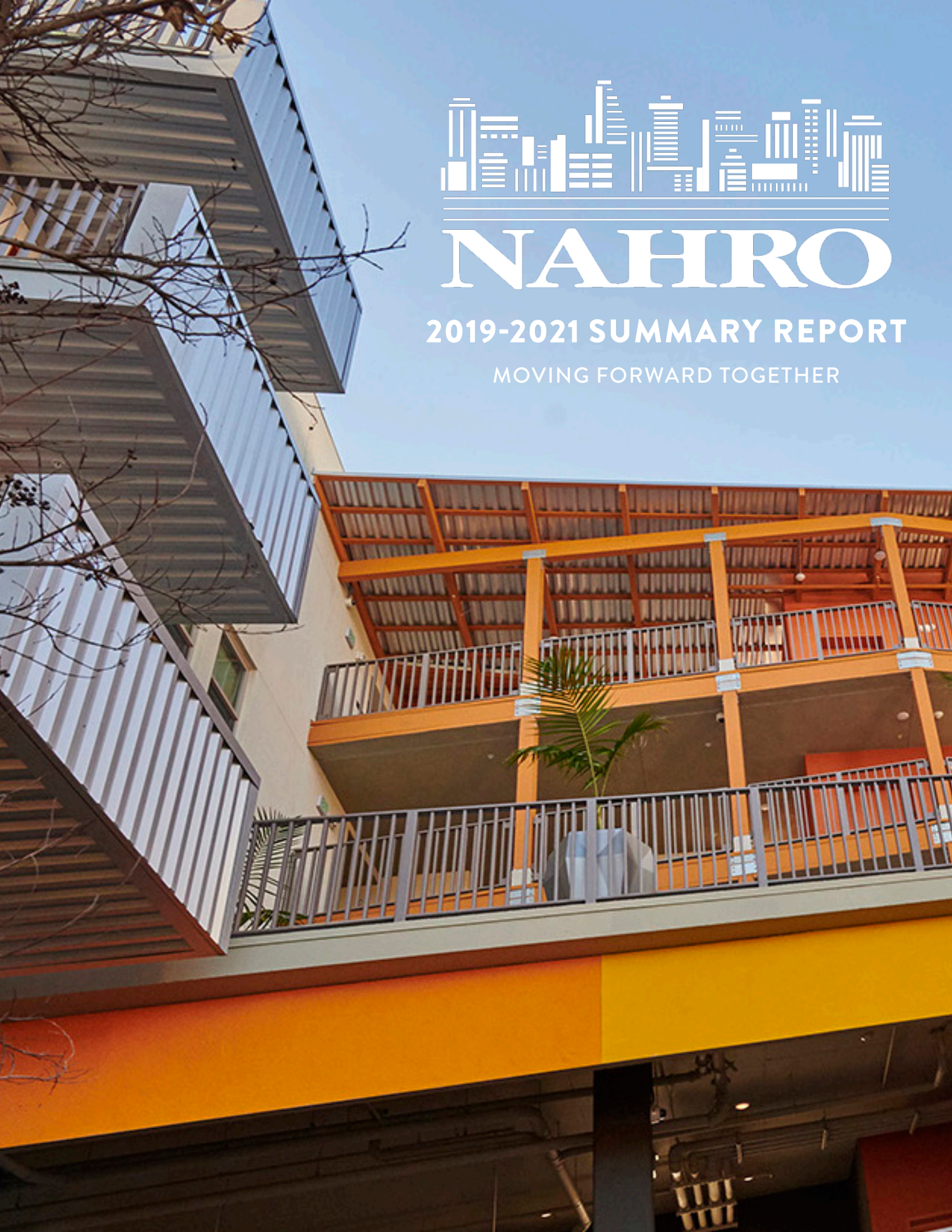

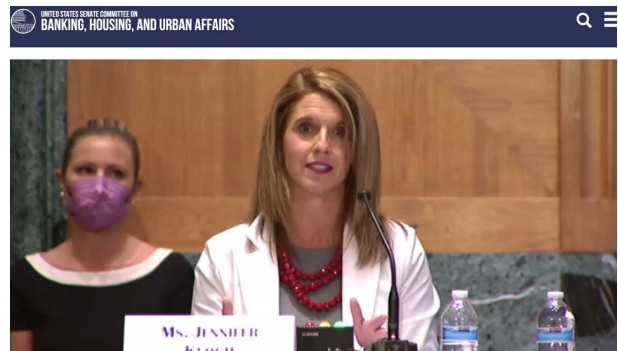

POWERFUL ADVOCACY

NAHRO's voice continues to ring loud and clear at HUD and on Capitol Hill. In August 2021 alone, NAHRO members and friends sent more than 43,000 letters to Congress and the White House to advocate for housing. Our advocacy successes include:

- \$12 billion in HUD funding and regulatory waivers in the CARES Act
- \$6 billion in HUD funding in the HEROES Act
- Low Income Housing Tax Credit reauthorization
- Increased funding for HUD programs
- The Housing is Infrastructure bill passing the full House

NAHRO staff and members have also testified in front of Congress seven times, and 13 members of Congress have spoken to our members. NAHRO staff has met regularly with HUD and sent nearly 20 comment letters to ensure your voices are heard in the regulatory process.

CAREER BUILDING

Through COVID-19, NAHRO has continued to provide essential information and professional development. From 2019-2021, the association has provided:

- More than 450 online training/technical assistance events reaching more than 5,000 professionals
- Five online conferences with more than 2,500 attendees

NAHRO also continues to invest in your professional future with new faculty members, an expanding certification program, new course offerings, and the revamping of existing training.

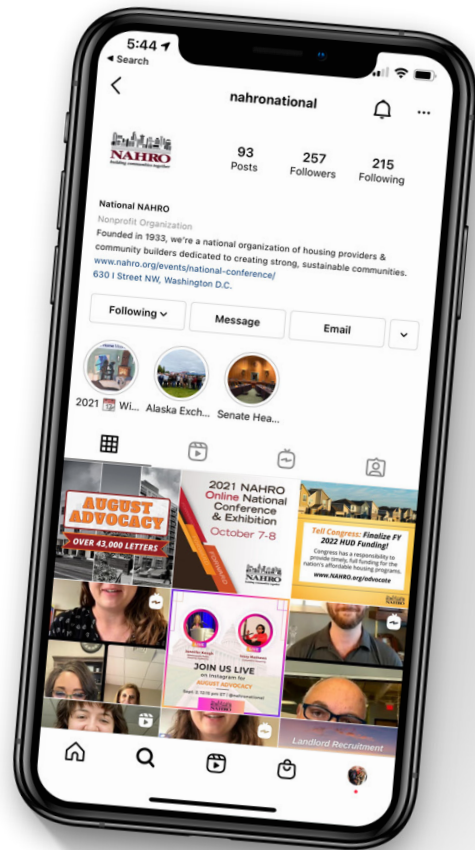
PARTNERSHIPS

NAHRO continues to strengthen bonds with local, national and international entities, including the Wells Fargo Equity Foundation, the Canadian Housing and Renewal Association, and more. In addition, the NAHRO-LDG Scholars program is now in its third year, with a total of ten brilliant students supported thus far.



STABILITY

NAHRO is financially healthy. During the COVID-19 pandemic, the association pivoted quickly from in-person conferences and training to virtual events, and successfully applied for both Paycheck Protection Program forgivable loan and a grant from the Wells Fargo Equity Foundation.



THOUGHT LEADERSHIP

NAHRO continues to be a respected and increasingly influential voice in affordable housing and community development. Over the past two years, NAHRO leadership and staff were quoted in more than 65 local and national media outlets. NAHRO also remains on the cutting edge of member and stakeholder communications, debuting a new website in April 2020 and growing its social media presence with a new Instagram account and nearly 6,000 Twitter followers.

NAHRO also hosted virtual events and members-only webinars on a variety of topics, including a day-long symposium on the voucher program.

HEALTHY COMMUNITIES

In February 2020, a new goal was added to NAHRO's strategic plan: advancing diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) as crucial to healthy communities. The association passed a DEI policy framework in 2021, and is working to expand its offerings in this space and integrate DEI issues into its curriculum.
