**Update on RAD Training and Next Steps**

CEO Todman updated SPAG on the RAD *Boot Camp* concept, which was provided to SPAG members prior to this teleconference. NAHRO staff has discussed the concept with Vice President Marsha Parham-Green, who originated the idea. Our goal is to deliver a pilot training in July 2019. Chairman Bergman confirmed with the SPAG members that no further action is required by SPAG because the draft proposal meets the expectations of SPAG on this issue. However, members should be aware of feedback/comments and any requests for specific training needs from NAHRO members.

**Future Housing Policy**

This topic will be discussed at SPAG's April 2019 meeting. NAHRO will engage a facilitator to guide our conversation. It was suggested that we tee up our conversation during the March teleconference.
